# Invitation Letter for First Stakeholders meeting

On **June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2014**, EMRP project **ENG62 MESaIL** "Metrology for Efficient and Safe Innovative Lighting", has successfully started (Call 2013, Metrology for Energy) aiming to deliver an advanced metrological framework for novel SSL to the threefold stakeholders community of:

**Standardization Bodies** by developing **measurement solutions** and/or delivering **guidelines** for large area (e.g. OLED & CoF), curved and pulsed SSL

**Test Laboratories** by providing **multifunctional transfer standards** applicable at NMI and test laboratory level aiming to provide not only traceability but also ability to characterise measurement system/facility for uncertainty analysis

**Industry/Institutes** by providing **metrics and equipment** accounting for safety/health concern of flicker and comfort/well-being aspects of novel SSL & assuring longer **lifetime** and providing its **traceability** through advanced modelling of reliability and investigation of ageing mechanisms of novel SSL

To assure the high level of collaboration with stakeholders **three stakeholders meetings have been planned** during the project in: **autumn 2014, spring 2016 and spring 2017**.

First stakeholders meeting on Sep 13, 2014, in Vienna, is held in connection with **CIE workshop on measurement uncertainty for industry** ([http://div2.cie.co.at/?i\\_ca\\_id=939](http://div2.cie.co.at/?i_ca_id=939)) and will be focused on establishment of **Stakeholders Committee**. During the last meeting in spring 2017 a joint **JRP-CIE training for stakeholders** shall be initiated aiming to introduce new developments in Advanced Metrology for novel SSL.

**ENG62 MESaIL aims to speed up standardization process** by its major contribution to written standards on international (CIE) and European (CEN) levels.

The project is coordinated by VSL and will be running for **3 years until May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2017**. The project consortium consists of 11 NMIs, a world-leading SSL manufacturer and two Technical Universities covering 11 countries. The total budget of the project is around 3.7 mln. €.
